Dear Mr. Notis:

Thank-you for your very prompt response to my letter of May 14 regarding In re Merck & Co., Inc Shareholder Litigation, DN HNT-C-14008-09. All references to Notice below refer to the April 15, 2010 notice of Settlement hearing papers mailed to stockholders.

Your response had an interesting interpretation of the word, may, especially in context of the entire paragraph – inferring that there *may* be other information not specifically stated. Explanation accepted. With that concept in mind and especially since this case concerns disclosure of all information I have the following questions concerning the case.

(1) How many shares of Merck stock do the lead plaintiffs Golombuski and Kahn own and for what time period? I assume that the number is small, perhaps only share one each, since the Notice does not specifically disclose that. In fact, there is no language to indicate that either owns any shares thus bringing into question their standing to sue.

(2) What compensation will Golombuski and Kahn receive for their part in this lawsuit either as a direct part of the settlement, as paid for services related to the case, or via some other means directly or indirectly? I ask this because a background check of both reveals that they are frequent plaintiffs in related cases as if that is a career. It is not reasonable to believe that they put forth efforts without compensation. Since the Notice does not specifically state that there is no compensation for them, I must assume that there is. Even if there were no direct compensation via the court am not so naive to believe that there is no private compensation or gratuity. Full disclosure is necessary.

I do not mean to be a pest so unless your response to these questions needs a reply; this is my final correspondence until I file written objections in the near future.
